Everyday Play Pack 2026 Games and Puzzle Giveaway Prize Draw Terms & Conditions

TERMS AND CONDITIONS: PRIZE DRAW

By participating in the **Everyday Play Pack Prize Draw** (the “Prize Draw”), you fully agree and accept these Prize Draw Terms and Conditions (“Prize Draw T&Cs”) together with any specific instructions and terms for such Prize Draw as may be found on the Host’s website. The Prize Draw will be hosted by Right To Play UK (the “**Host**”).

1. PROMOTER

a) The promoters of this Prize Draw are:

2. ELIGIBILITY

a) The Prize Draw is open to individual entrants in the UK. Companies / organisations are not eligible to enter the Prize Draw.

b) Entrants must be eighteen (18) years of age or over at the time of entry. Proof of identity may be required. This must be provided on request.

c) Employees of the Host, RTP, or their family members or anyone else connected in any way with the Prize Draw or helping to set up the Prize Draw, shall not be permitted to enter.

d) All entries must be made directly by the person entering the Prize Draw.

e) By entering the Prize Draw, the entrant confirms that all information submitted is true, current and complete.

3. ENTERING THE PRIZE DRAW

a) Participation in the Prize Draw is voluntary and does not require you to purchase anything, nor to donate to the Host.

b) The Prize Draw can be entered in the following ways:

i. ii. Through a Meta Lead Form on Facebook or Instagram operated by Right To Play UK (“RTP UK”), by submitting your personal details (name and email address) to download the Power of Play Pack.

iii. No illegible, incomplete, forged, mechanically reproduced or altered entries will be accepted. All entries become the property of the Host and/or Promoters and will not be returned.

d) The Prize Draw opens on **29 July 2026** (“Opening Date”). The Prize Draw closes at 9pm GMT on **3 September 2026** (“Closing Date”). All Postal Entries must be received within two (2) business days of the Closing Date (“Postal Closing Date”). After the Closing Date and the Postal Closing Date no further entries into the Prize Draw will be permitted.

e) No responsibility is accepted for entries not received for whatever reason, including for entries lost, delayed or corrupted, or due to computer error in transit.

f) The winning entrants will be selected at random by the Host via a computerised system producing random results from all entries received by the Closing Date and the Postal Closing Date in accordance with these Prize Draw T&Cs.

g) The winners will be notified by the Host by email address or contact number provided upon entering the Prize Draw within five (5) days of the Postal Closing Date.

h) Reasonable efforts will then be made to contact the winners by the host following this. The host will email winners from 3 September 2026. In this email the host will request further information from the winner, such as but not limited to, their postal address. If the winners cannot be contacted within 72 hours of being notified that they have won or if a winning entrant fails to communicate their acceptance of the Prize to the Foundation within 72 hours of being contacted and/or if the winner is unable to comply with these Prize Draw T&Cs, the Hosts reserve the right to offer the Prize to the next eligible entrant drawn at random.

4. PRIZE DRAW – PRIZES

- a) The **prize draw** bundles that are available to win in this giveaway include games and toys for children, drawn and awarded to a randomly selected winner.

 - b) The host will be responsible for coordinating and sending out the Prize to the chosen winner within 5 working days of receiving confirmation from that winner that they accept the Prize they have won.

 - c) By accepting a Prize, each winner agrees to comply with all applicable terms and conditions and regulations and acknowledges that the Promoters may withdraw a Prize should they consider that a winner is not acting in accordance with these Prize Draw T&Cs.

 - d) No cash alternative to a Prize will be offered. Each Prize is non-refundable and non-transferable. Prizes are subject to availability. In the event of a Prize being unavailable, the Promoters reserve the right to offer an alternative prize of equal or greater value.

6. PERSONAL DATA

- a) By participating in the Prize Draw, you acknowledge that your name, address, email address, and country of residence will have been made available to the Host (as set out above).

c) After signing up to take part in the Power of Play 2025 Giveaway, we would love to share more about the work of Right To Play and our upcoming summer activities. Your Personal Data will be used in accordance with our privacy policy linked above and you can opt-out of communications at any time.

7. GENERAL

a) Any entrant must comply with any directions given to him or her by the Promoters including, but not limited to, any and all relevant laws, rules and regulations.

b) Any entrant who enters or attempts to enter the Prize Draw in a manner, which in the Promoters' determination, is contrary to these Prize Draw T&Cs or is unfair, fraudulent or unjust to other entrants or is otherwise not in the spirit of the Prize Draw (including without limitation tampering with the operation of the Prize Draw, hacking, cheating, deception, or any other unfair playing practices such as intending to annoy, abuse, threaten, or harass any other entrants or the Promoters and/or any of its agents or representatives), may be rejected from the Prize Draw at the Promoters' discretion.

c) The Promoters may cancel or amend the Prize Draw, the Prizes, or these Prize Draw T&Cs without prior notice and for any reason, including (without limitation) in the case of a manifest error. Any changes will be posted within these Prize Draw T&Cs.

d) The Promoters cannot guarantee that the services relating to the Prize Draw will be free from errors or omissions nor that they will be available uninterrupted and in a fully operating condition. Without limiting clause 7(c), the Promoters reserve the right to modify, cancel, terminate or suspend the Prize Draw in whole or in part, at its sole discretion, if it believes the Prize Draw is not capable of being conducted as specified in these Prize Draw T&Cs or in the event of system failure, maintenance or repair, network issue, a virus, computer bug or unauthorised human intervention or any other cause that is beyond the reasonable control of the Promoters that could corrupt or affect the administration, security, impartiality, or normal course of the Prize Draw, including, but not limited to the unavailability of the vote, poll, competition or Prize Draw entry platform before the closing date, or for strike, lock-out, labour dispute, illness, act of God, natural disaster, adverse weather conditions, war, riot, civil commotion, accident, epidemic or pandemic, malicious damage, fire, flood and/or storm, compliance with law or governmental order, rule, regulation or direction, breakdown of plant, machinery or transportation. The Promoters are not responsible for any loss or damage caused to you as a result of any of these occurrences.

e) The Promoters will not be liable to you for any loss that is not foreseeable, and the

Promoters exclude their liability to the maximum extent permitted by law. Nothing in these Prize Draw T&Cs shall limit or exclude liability for death or personal injury as a result of the Promoters' negligence, fraud or fraudulent misrepresentation or for any other liability which may not be excluded by law.

f) You agree to reimburse the Promoters in respect of any damages suffered by the Promoters or any losses by the Promoters resulting from any claim made by a third party in each case in respect of any matter arising from your entry to the Prize Draw, your use of the services relating to the Prize Draw in breach of the Prize Draw T&Cs or from your violating of any applicable law or regulation.
